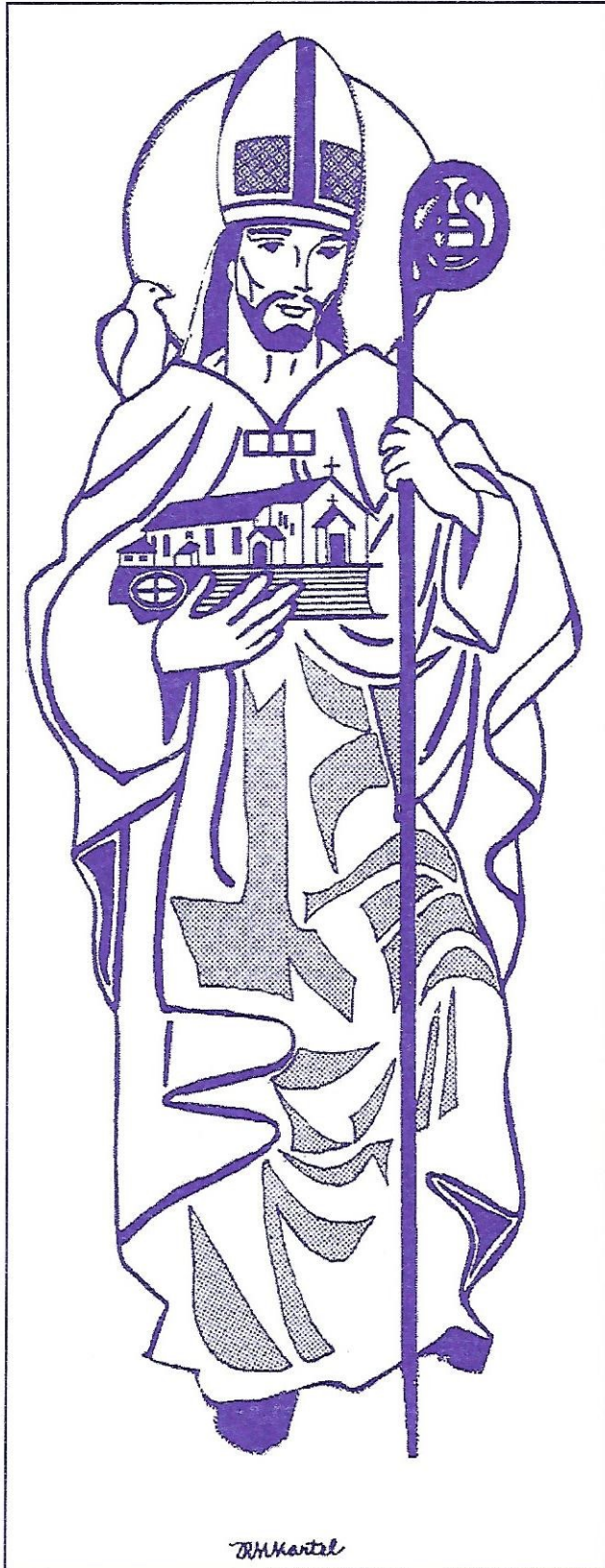

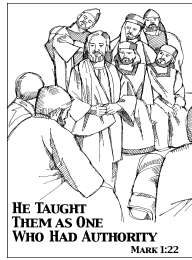

Print your Online Giving Year End Tax Statements:

1. Log in to your Online Giving donor account.
2. Click on "View My Giving History & Tax Information".
3. On the right side, click the "Print" button.
4. Set your date range from 1/1/2017 to 12/31/2017
5. Change the report type to "Full Detail Report (Tax Purposes)".
6. Leave the tax filter option checked.
7. Click "Print". Your report will open in a new window.
8. Export the report to a PDF (click on the PDF link at the top of the screen. This will open the report as a PDF and will let you print the report. Make sure browser pop-up blocker is OFF.)
