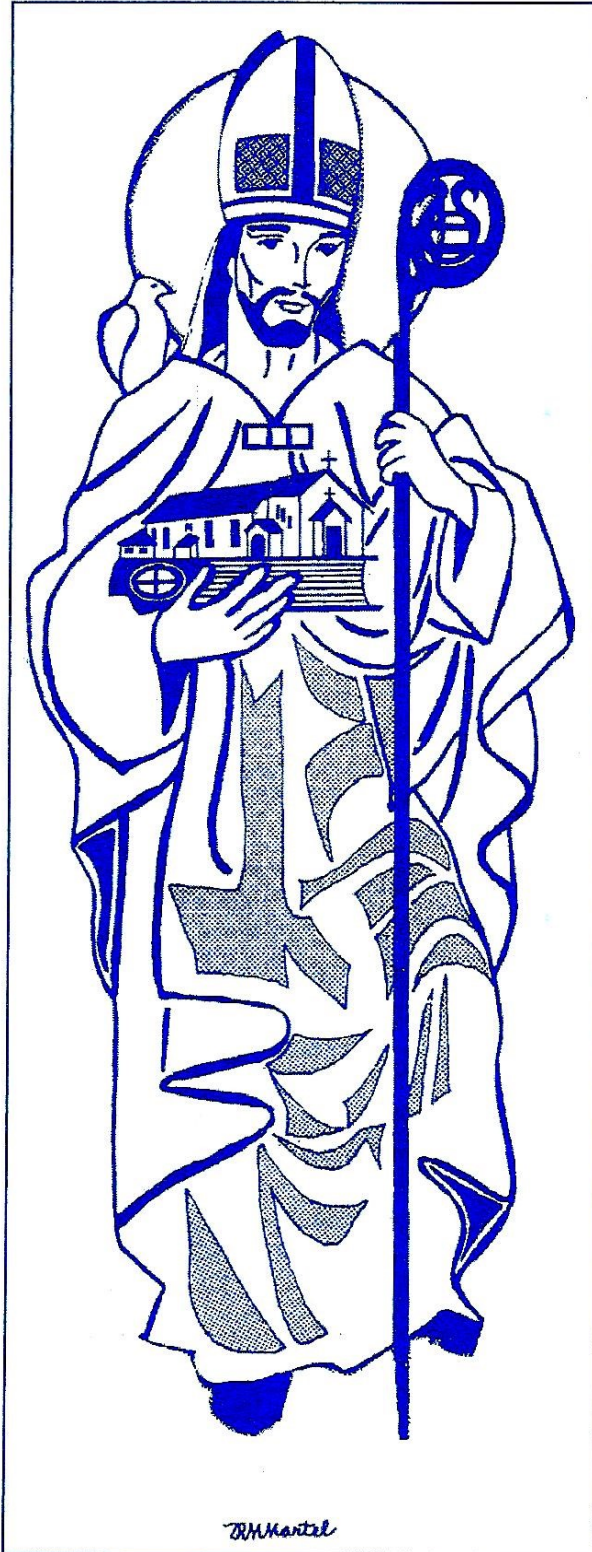

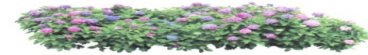

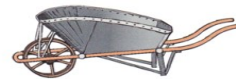


**May 6<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup>, 8a to 2p**

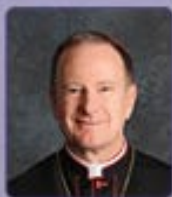
