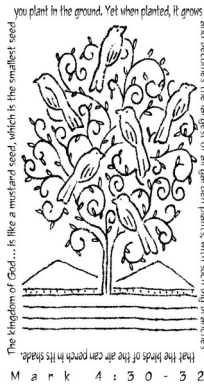

CRS Response to Volcanic Eruption

Guatemala experienced an eruption of Volcan de Fuego on Sunday, June 3. The country's most violent volcano eruption in more than a century affecting more than 1.7 million people. There are 3,000 people staying in temporary shelters out of the 12,000 who were evacuated from the area. Searches are continuing under difficult conditions, but there are fears that heavy rain could cause fresh landslides of volcanic mud. Catholic Relief Services is working with Caritas Escuintla to assess immediate needs across the affected communities. Prayers and financial contributions are needed for our Guatemalan sisters and brothers facing this tragedy. Documents needed in order to be assisted same day:

- 2 copies of your Permanent Resident Card (front and back)
- Social Security card and passport
- Completed Worksheet (on back of this flyer)
- If you are married, marriage certificate
- If you or your current spouse are divorced, divorce certificate(s)
- Documentation of all arrests, detentions, and/or citations, including reason for the arrest, date, place, and outcome/disposition. Bring ALL arrest records and Certified Court Documents, even if charges were dropped or record expunged.

The filing fee is \$725 made payable to "U.S. Department of Homeland Security" (If you are over 75 years old, the filing fee is \$640)

To see if you are eligible for a fee waiver please bring either of the following:

- 2017 Taxes with W-2
- Proof that you or a relevant household member currently receive public benefits, such as SSI, IHSS, Medi-Cal, food stamps/ CalFresh, WIC, CalWorks, Cash Assistance, etc. Please bring a Benefit Verification Letter showing when benefits started and current status.
