Fifty years ago on July 25, 1968 Pope Paul VI promulgated his Encyclical Letter *HUMANAE VITAE*. Although this letter is both insightful and prophetic, it has not been well received by the universal church, including the clergy. In today's first reading we hear from the Prophet Jeremiah: "thus says the LORD, the God of Israel, against the shepherds who shepherd my people: You have scattered my sheep and driven them away. You have not cared for them, but I will take care to punish your evil deeds. I myself will gather the remnant of my flock from all the lands to which I have driven them and bring them back to their meadow; there they shall increase and multiply." (Jer. 23:2-5). 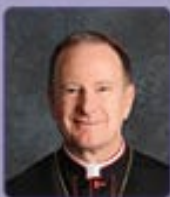
