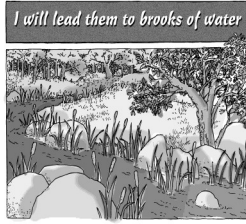

He wrote and published several volumes of church music. His "Erster Theil Deutscher Sonntaglicher Evangelien Spruche (1612)" contains "Jesus sprach zu dem Blinden" a setting of the Gospel (Jesus saith to the blind man, What wilt thou that I shall do unto thee? And he said, Lord, that I may receive my sight. And Jesus said unto him, Receive thy sight: thy faith hath saved thee. And immediately he received his sight, and followed him, glorifying God: and all the people, when they saw it, gave praise unto God.)

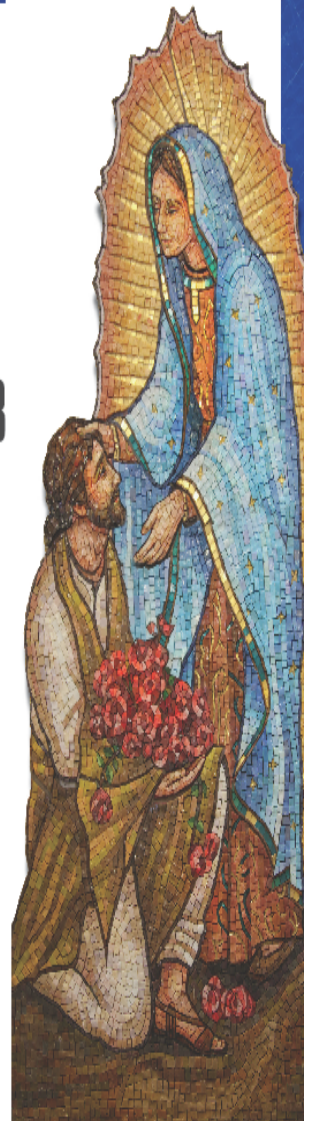
