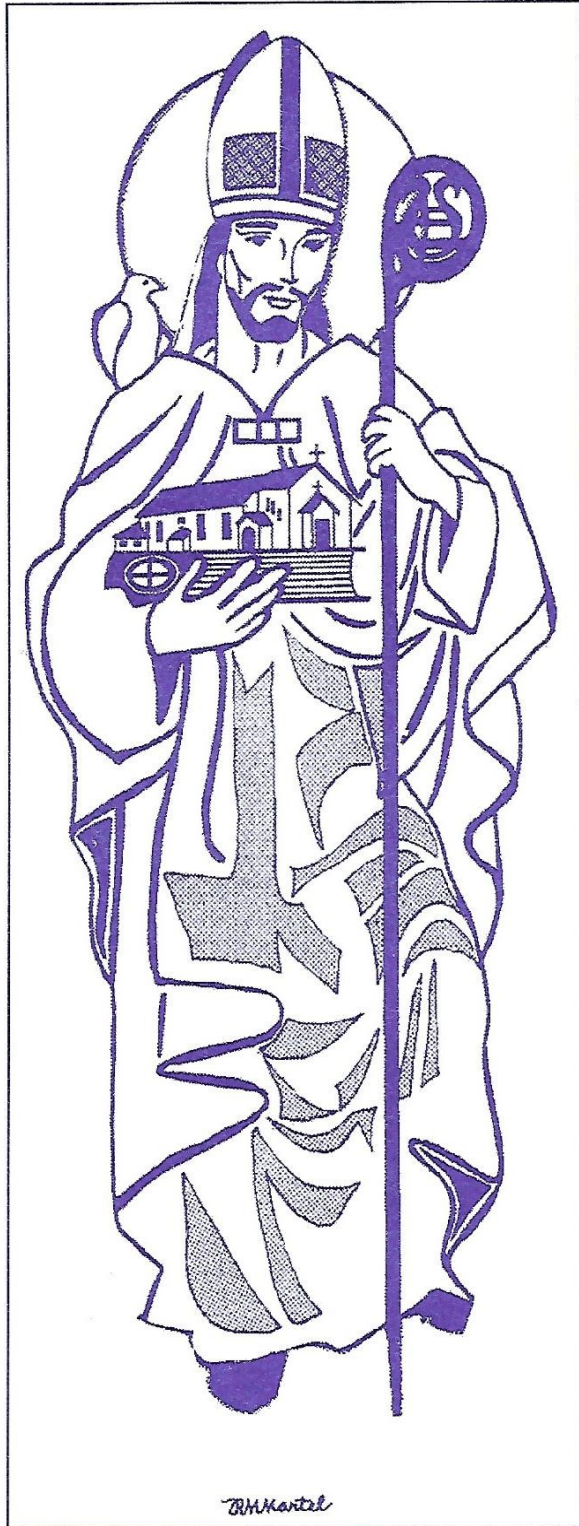

Pastor's COLUMN

"If you are the Son of God" (Lk 4:3). The devil began with these words in two out of the three temptations Jesus had to endure. He did something similar to Adam and Eve: "Did God really say, 'You shall not eat from any of the trees in the garden?'" (Gen 3:1). He uses some truth, even quoting Sacred Scripture, to engage and ensnare us. He knows who we are and who God is. He knows and resents that we are children of God, created in God's image and likeness. He tricks us when he gets us to take advantage of our privilege and consider serving ourselves rather than our Creator. We can see in today's gospel that Jesus survives these temptations by not entertaining the devil, imagining what it would be like to reign in this world. Our Lord's responses are short and to the point:

- 1) "It is written, *One does not live on bread alone.*"
- 2) "It is written:
You shall worship the Lord, your God, and him alone shall you serve."
- 3) "It also says,
You shall not put the Lord, your God, to the test."

May God help us to do the same when we feel tempted.

Fasting is understood as the taking of only one full meal a day, binding on all who are age 18-59 (inclusive) in good health.

Abstinence consists in refraining from the consumption of meat, binding on all who are age 14 and older.

All are encouraged to see that children who are not bound by the obligations are led to appreciate an authentic sense of penance.
