Graduale Romanum Introit (ABC= Psalm 42:1,2,3) *Iudica me Deus, * et discerne causam meam de gente non sancta: ab homine iniquo et doloso eripe me: quia tu es Deus meus, et fortitudo mea. PS. Emitte lucem tuam, et veritatem tuam: ipsa me deduxerunt, et adduxerunt in montem sanctum tuum, et in tabernacula tua.* (Vindicate me, O God, and defend my cause against an ungodly nation; from wicked and deceitful men deliver me, for you are my God and my strength. General Instruction of the Roman Missal # 45 (Mar 2003)

Sacred silence also, as part of the celebration, is to be observed at the designated times. Its purpose, however, depends on the time it occurs in each part of the celebration. Thus within the Act of Penitence and again after the invitation to pray, all recollect themselves; but at the conclusion of a reading or the homily, all meditate briefly on what they have heard; then after Communion, they praise and pray to God in their hearts.

Even before the celebration itself, it is commendable that silence to be observed in the church, in the sacristy, in the vesting room, and in adjacent areas, so that all may dispose themselves to carry out the sacred action in a devout and fitting manner.

Fasting is understood as the taking of only one full meal a day, binding on all who are age 18-59 (inclusive) in good health.
Abstinence consists in refraining from the consumption of meat, binding on all who are age 14 and older.
All are encouraged to see that children who are not bound by the obligations are led to appreciate an authentic sense of penance.

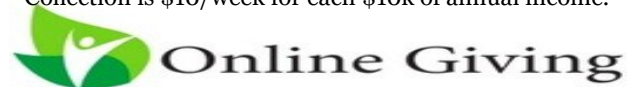
