Dear Parishioners of St. David of Wales,

I am Fr. Benedict Pradit Wonganant or you can call me Fr.Ben. I was ordained to the priesthood on May 18, 2013. I was born into a large Catholic family, in a Catholic village in the northeast of Thailand. I have two older brothers and two older sisters and four younger sisters. I am the middle child. My brothers and sisters, all of them are married. One of them is living in Petaluma/Santa Rosa. My Dad passed away 19 years ago (2000).

The life of the village as well as that of my family was always Church centered. We not only went to Mass on Sunday but we would be in Church almost every morning and most evenings. Our parish school was staffed by Sisters who were very attentive to our learning and faith and they encouraged us to think about becoming priests.

The desire to be a priest came to me very early and at the age of twelve my family sent me to study in the city of Ubon, which is about sixty miles from our village. My next step was to move near to Bangkok (capital city) which is many hundreds of miles from my home to study more as there was much for me to learn. I had to work very hard to make a living and worked in the fruit and vegetable market where I gained a lot of experience meeting many different people.

The desire to be a priest staved with me all the time. When I was asked by a priest friend (Fr. Terence O' Malley) if I would like to become a priest in the Diocese of Oakland, I felt that God was answering my prayers.

I studied at St. Patrick's Seminary in Menlo Park for six years and Graduated with a Master of Divinity (M.Div). I am happy and enjoy life here and am thankful that I am gaining knowledge and the grace that will help me to do what I believe God desires of me. I love meeting people and find that people here in the United States are not unlike the people at home and people elsewhere.

I am happy and proud to be here at St. David of Wales to work with all of you and of course I need your help and cooperation. I am entirely new to this parish and I ask each and every one you to please pray for me in this transition. I promise with the help of God's grace to do my best to serve you well. Every one of you will be in my Masses. This is my 5th parish assignment, having served as parochial vicar at St.Patrick Rodeo, St.Mary Walnut-Creek, St.Leander San Leandro, St.Edward Newark, and now as parochial administrator at St.David Richmond with all of you.

Again Please keep me in your prayers, so that I may always do God's will.

A Little About Kenneth! Kenneth has been in the St. David community for 21 years, since he was in Kindergartner. His great-grandparents joined the parish in 1982. Two of Kenneth's older cousins preceded him in attending and graduating from St. David School, so when Kenneth was born, there was no doubt that his family would enroll him here. He began Kindergarten in the 1997-1998 school year and continued his education at St. David School all the way through 8th grade, graduating with the class of 2006. Kenneth then went on to graduate from Salesian High School (now Salesian College Preparatory) with the class of 2010.

When it was time to declare a major in college, Kenneth knew he wanted to be a teacher, and had no problem declaring his major when he arrived to California State University, East Bay in the Fall of 2010. Kenneth graduated from CSUEB in the Spring of 2014 with a Bachelor of Arts Degree in Liberal Arts and a Minor in Human Development. Kenneth was also fortunate enough to play basketball at the collegiate level for the Men's Basketball team at CSUEB all four years. While at CSUEB, Kenneth continued giving back to St. David by serving as a Eucharistic Minister at Mass during weekends and summers.

Two days after graduating from CSUEB, Kenneth began his graduate studies at St. Mary's College of California. While obtaining his teaching credential, Kenneth needed a placement school to earn his Student Teaching hours. He chose to come back to St. David school and student teach in the 4th grade classroom for the beginning of the 2014-2015 school year. Two months after beginning, his student teaching placement turned into a long-term substitute teaching position in the 4th grade. Kenneth would go on to earn an official teaching position in the 2015-2016 school year. The following spring, Kenneth earned his Master of Arts Degree in Teaching from St. Mary's College of California. In the 2017-2018 school year, he earned an additional role as the Vice Principal of St. David School. Five years and five homeroom classes later, Kenneth will leave the classroom and become a fulltime administrator at his Alma Mater, St. David School.
